Integration/Deployment Facility – New Equipment

Understanding the System design life cycle, InquisIT realized the need for a centralized Integration/Deployment facility to support our customers when it is time for their technology refresh. InquisIT designed this facility in Chantilly, Virginia with the intention of providing our customers a “one stop shop”. In our integration and deployment facility we can help our customers in the very beginning of their refresh process by helping to design the system specifications for the new equipment they will purchase. We can then develop a standard image using customer supplied software to be deployed across the entire lot of the new equipment. Finally, we can receive, store, and ship the equipment with any shipping vendor or deliver locally with our delivery vehicles. Depending on our customer’s requirements, InquisIT can also provide integration services to install the new equipment once delivered onsite. InquisIT prides itself in being flexible to adapt our customer’s needs. Any combination of the capabilities that we have described can be purchased individually or combined together.

Image, Burn-in and test

Burn-in racks are used to deploy images to new equipment, burn-in or test equipment and sanitize data. The racks are mobile for use anywhere within the facility to prevent potential mixing of equipment. Each rack will accommodate 16-24 computers at a time depending on their size.

Receiving and Storage of GFE

All materials are checked against the bill of lading at time of receipt to ensure timely corrective measures if there are any issues. Any damaged equipment is immediately rejected and replacements are ordered. All equipment is then entered into InquisIT's approved tracking system. The InquisIT facility provides secure storage with 24 hour monitoring, and is climate controlled.





Integration/Deployment Facility

InquisIT has two 4400 sq. ft Integration facilities. All equipment is stored in unique bin location. Each bin handles two skids with approximately 20 – 40 units per skid. InquisIT tracks all activity relative to each item to ensure proper and complete asset management of all equipment received. “Real-time” asset tracking can be made available via web portal (Customized specific to customers needs, on a per project basis).





Delivery/Shipping/Relocation

Local delivery services are available in the Washington D.C. metropolitan area. In addition to the local delivery we can also provide “long-haul” delivery services to support the entire East Coast. InquisIT is also able to work with all major shipping vendors using our Corporate accounts, charged back as an ODC, or by using a customer provided shipping account. InquisIT staff has over 10 years experience and the equipment available to do local office relocations. We provide all materials required to safely and securely relocate any and all types of equipment.

Delivery Scalability

- InquisIT has the ability to scale our delivery services to meet your specific needs; whether you have hundreds of pieces of equipment going from loading dock to loading dock, from one state to another, just a few pieces of equipment going from one building to another within the same city, or even if you are just moving from floor to floor within the same building. We provide the right staff with the right equipment to get the job done right the first time.





Integration/Deployment Facility – Legacy Equipment

Generally, a technology refresh will result in some amount of legacy equipment that must be excessed. InquisIT can process this “*end-of-life*” equipment and prepare it for disposal or redistribution. Though requirements vary, InquisIT commonly provides asset management, storage, removal of any identifiable markings and data sanitization services to support the processing of legacy equipment. InquisIT ensures security and integrity through traceability. All hard drives are cleaned in accordance with Department of Defense high-level security wiping procedures (5220.22M). Accountability and tracking are paramount as we process each piece of equipment and our staff pays careful attention to document all required information. Once processed, InquisIT will coordinate and/or deliver the equipment to an agreed upon location or disposal facility. Through established relationships with agencies such as Unicom Federal Prison Industries, InquisIT can coordinate the disposal of equipment with little or no cost to the Government. This type of recycling of “*end-of-life*” equipment can even result in credits for the individual components.

Integration/Deployment Facility

Specific areas defined for newly received equipment, “in Process” equipment, equipment that is ready to be delivered/shipped, and equipment designated as excess. InquisIT employs Government approved hard disk handling techniques to ensure all legacy systems are sanitized prior to being excessed. Equipment is palletized and shrink wrapped or banded depending on size and weight in preparation for delivery.
